## PreK \& Kindergarten:

Please label the following items with your child's name:

- Water Bottle (Non-spillable)
- 2 folders with pockets
- Change of clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, and socks. Put them in a sealed and labeled plastic bag, does not have to be school uniform clothing)
- 1 pack of 24 crayons (no larger please)
- 6 regular size glue sticks (no extra-large glue sticks or liquid glue please)
- 1 Black Expo fine tipped dry erase marker
- 1 notebook (spiral or composition)


## First \& Second Grade:

- NO-Spill water bottle
- 12 - \#2 pencils (please label with sharpie near the eraser)
- Colored pencils
- Pencil sharpener (one of the little ones)
- 5" scissors
- Pencil Box
- 4 glue sticks
- $12^{\prime \prime}$ ruler with cenitmeters
- $11 / 2$ " 3 -ringed binder (any color or design)
- 6 folders with pockets \& three hole punched: One each of Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue \& Purple
- 1 folder of any color/design for homework
- 1 Spiral bound notebook for Math
- A Bible

## Ninth through Twelfth Grade:

- A 12" ruler (both scales)
- A basic scientific calculator (inexpensive ones are fine, but they need the scientific functions)
- A 6 " protractor and a math compass
- 2 or more 3 ringed binders (Binders can be divided into different class sections or students may have a binder for each subject.)
- 2 spiral notebooks, 1 for math and 1 for science. These are for notetaking only. No work should be turned in from these notebooks. See below.
- 1000 sheets wide rule paper (Neither teacher will not accept papers torn out of spiral notebooks including the microperf pages.)
- 300 index cards
- 2 pocket folders
- Book cover material for 6 books (Have these in school on first day to cover books in class.)
- 50 sheets $1 / 4$ graph paper
- A study Bible (Teacher uses New King James)
- 2 boxes of tissues to share with the class
