PreK & Kindergarten:

Please label the following items with your child's name:

- 6 regular size glue sticks (Elmer's is preferred)
- 1 bottle Elmer's White Glue
- 1 pack colored pencils (Crayola is good)
- 4 #2 pencils (yellow, not characters etc.)
- 1 Box of 24 crayons (Crayola is good)
- 1 pack of 8 color watercolors (Crayola is good)
- 2 boxes of facial tissue

First & Second Grade:

- NO-Spill water bottle
- 12 #2 pencils (please label with sharple near the eraser)
- Colored pencils
- 1 Pack of 24 crayons
- 5" scissors
- 4 glue sticks
- 12" ruler with centimeters
- 6 folders with pockets & three hole punched: One each of Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue & Purple
- 1 folder of any color/design for homework
- 1 large eraser or 1 pack of pencil-cap erasers
- A Bible
- 1 drawstring bag for gym clothes

For the class to share:

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 box of quart or gallon ziplock bags
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 container of Clorox wipes

Third Grade & Fourth Grade:

- Bible
- 1 Red Plastic 2-pocket folder with 3 prongs
- 1 Student scissors
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 small pack of fine tip Dry Erase Markers
- 1 Three ringed binders 1" or 2"
- 5 Plastic pocket dividers for binders
- 8 Glue sticks (Elmer's is preferred)
- 1 pack wide ruled notebook paper

- 24 Yellow #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- 1 pack of pencil cap erasers
- 2 child size water bottles. One for AM, one for PM.
 Larger bottles tip too easily.
- 1 drawstring bag for PE clothes
- 1 small to medium sized drawing pad
- Optional: Shared supplies-boxes of tissues, quart or gallon zip lock bags, paper towels, wipes, white or clear Elmers liquid craft glue, incentive stickers, rubber bands, large dry erase markers, small paper or plastic cups, colored pencils
- For Grade 3 Math: one Pocket Folder

Fifth & Sixth Grade:

- 2 pencil pouches (no pencil boxes please)

- 1 three ringed binder 1"
- 1 pack 5-tab dividers with pockets
- 1 yellow plastic pocket folder (no prongs)
- 2 packages of wide ruled loose-leaf paper
- 2 packages of 3X5 lined index cards
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 1 pack of washable markers
- 1 120-page spiral notebook
- 4 fine tip dry erase markers
- 1 package of highlighters
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes to share w/class
- 1 boxes of tissues to share with class
- 1 roll of paper towels to share with class
- A string bag for gym clothes
- For Grade 5 Math: 120-page spiral notebook and one Pocket Folder

Seventh and Eighth Grade:

- 2 packages of Mechanical pencils (Mechanical only please.)

- Soft Pencil pouch (No boxes please)
- 8 packs of 3X5 note cards

- 2 composition notebooks (NO spiral bound please)
- One 1-1/2" binder
- 1 pack tab dividers with pockets for binder
- Scissors
- 3 folders with pockets
- 5 Paper bags to cover books (no handles)
- Tissues
- 1 Large Bag of candy
- For Grade 7 Math: <u>120-page spiral notebook</u> and <u>one Pocket Folder</u> and one <u>1" or 1.5" 3-ring binder</u> <u>with 100 sheets of loose-leaf paper</u>
- Eighth Grade Only a basic calculator (not scientific)

Ninth through Twelfth Grade:

- #2 pencils (mechanical is fine)
- Dark blue or black pens (<u>NO</u> reds, pinks, purples, greens etc.)
- A 12" ruler (both scales)
- A basic scientific calculator (inexpensive ones are fine, but they need the scientific functions)
- 2 or more 3 ringed binders (Binders can be divided into different class sections or students may have a binder for each subject.)
- 2 spiral notebooks, 1 for math and 1 for science.
 These are for notetaking only. No work should be turned in from these notebooks. See below.
- 1000 sheets wide rule loose-leaf paper (<u>Neither</u> teacher will accept papers torn out of spiral notebooks including the microperf pages.)
- 300 index cards
- 2 pocket folders
- Book cover material for 6 books (Have these in school on first day to cover books in class.)
- 50 sheets 1/4" graph paper
- A study Bible (Teacher uses New King James)
- 2 boxes of tissues to share with the class
